18 TO THE CHICO POLICE DEPARMENT AND THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF  
19 JUSTICE:

20 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. [REDACTED]  
21 [REDACTED] is determined to be factually innocent of the arrest on  
22 September 1, 2006 for an alleged violation of Health & Safety Code  
23 Section 11357(a) (Possession of Concentrated Cannabis). Mr. [REDACTED] is  
24 hereby exonerated.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hereafter, the arrest shall be deemed not  
27 to have occurred, and Mr. [REDACTED] may answer any questions relating to

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. [REDACTED] is granted the relief provided  
2 in subdivision (b) of Penal Code § 851.8. The Chico Police  
3 Department and the Department of Justice are ordered to seal their  
4 records of the arrest and the court order to seal and destroy such  
5 records, for three years from the date of the arrest, and thereafter  
6 to destroy their records of the arrest and the court order to seal  
7 and destroy such records. The Chico Police Department and the  
8 Department of Justice are further ordered to request the destruction  
9 of any records of the arrest which have been given to any local,  
10 state, or federal agency, person, or entity.
