Dear Mr. Figueroa,

The following is the response on behalf of the Kings County District Attorney's Office, to your request for records under the California Public Records Act, Section 6250 *et seq.* of the Government Code ("CPRA"), which was received by the District Attorney's Office on June 14, 2013. In your request, you seek the following:

"Any and all documents or information concerning medical marijuana, Proposition 215 (codified as Health and Safety Code § 11362.5) and/or Senate Bill 420 (codified as Health and Safety Code §§ 11362.7-11362.83), including, but not limited to, any and all guidelines, bulletins, orders, directives, policies, and/or protocols. Please provide any and all documents or information concerning medical marijuana doctors, patients, caregivers, dispensaries, collectives, cooperatives and/or associations."

The District Attorney's Office has no responsive documents and, therefore, cannot comply with your request. However, the County does possess certain documents concerning medical marijuana which have been provided to you as part of a similar request from your office received by the Kings County Sheriff's Office. Those documents are:

1. The Sheriff's current policy on Medical Marijuana, Policy No. 452, and
2. Kings County Ordinances 14-50 through 14-55.

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
