RE: California Public Records Act Request received June 17, 2013

Dear Mr. Figueroa,

The Shasta County Sheriff's Office ("SCSO") is in receipt of your request for records received June 17, 2013, made under the California Public Records Act ("CPRA"). In your CPRA request, you seek all documents related to medical marijuana, specified California statutes, and "patients, caregivers, dispensaries, collectives, cooperatives, and/or associations." While the request describes certain types of records sought (such as guidelines and bulletins), it states that it is not limited to the types of records identified. As the request is directed to Shasta County Sheriff Tom Bosenko, we interpret it to seek documents only in the custody of the Sheriff's Office, and not in the custody of any other administrative subdivision of the County of Shasta, its Board of Supervisors, other County public officers, or the State of California.

As an initial matter, your CPRA request is extraordinary over broad, and is so vague that it is difficult to discern the specific types of records you seek. In other words, the broad nature of the request does not permit us to easily identify the records that you seek. However, based on the general language in your request, we interpret it to seek SCSO policies and protocols relating to medical marijuana.

With respect to category of records regarding policies and procedures, the SCSO does not hold any independent written policies and procedures as we adhere exclusively to the policies and procedures held by the Shasta County Planning Department.

In addition, to the extent that the CPRA request seeks disclosure of particular operational plans/orders issued pursuant to such policies, such documents shall not be disclosed as they constitute intelligence information, which is exempt from disclosure under Government Code Section 6254(f).

The requested release of information regarding particular patients and caregivers implicates their privacy rights under Article I, Section 1 of the California Constitution. Such information is exempt from disclosure pursuant to a CPRA request under Government Code § 6254(k).
