TFRMS TO KNOW

Local Authorization: Each premises you operate must be in compliance with the laws and ordinances of the city and/or county in which it is located.

Owner: Anyone with at least 20% ownership interest in the company, the CEO, the Board of Directors (for nonprofits), partners (for partnerships), members of an LLC, officers and directors (for corporations), or who is involved in the direction, control or management of the company.

Financial Interest Holder: Anyone who holds less than 20% ownership and does not participate in the day to day direction, operation and control of the company. This does not include financial institutions providing loans, entities holding liens on the property, etc.

Live Scan: A criminal background check process, administered by the California Department of Justice (DOJ). Sign up for the MCSB email list to be notified when the 'Request for Live Scan' form is available: www.cdph.ca.gov/contactmcsb.

Premises: The property where cannabis manufacturing will occur.

Owners must disclose all criminal convictions. If an owner was convicted of a substantially related crime, evidence of rehabilitation can be included with the application for consideration during the license review process.

The information submitted in the licensing system is subject to California Public Records Act requests. For operational procedures that must be included in the application, you can provide descriptions of the procedures to protect from disclosure of trade secrets, or clearly mark the documents as confidential in accordance with Civil Code section 3426.1(d).
